

Entrance Scholarships

Entrance scholarships are available for students beginning the first-year of a full time degree program. Scholarships are awarded primarily on academic, athletics and personal achievement. Many of our Rundle graduates are awarded entrance scholarships at their post-secondary school of choice including:

Undergraduate Scholarships and Awards

President's Scholars of Excellence - University of Toronto, the most highly qualified students applying to first year of direct-entry, undergraduate studies will be distinguished as President's Scholars of Excellence. Outstanding domestic and international secondary school students are considered automatically for the President's Scholars of Excellence Program (PSEP) upon admission.

Value: \$10,000

Shad Alumni Entrance Scholarship - Faculty of Engineering, McMaster University, award based on academic performance, demonstrated leadership experience and attributes, involvement in extra-curricular and/or volunteer activities.

Value: \$5,000

Saxton Volleyball Scholarship - awarded to exceptional individuals who have become role models for other athletes through their consistent pursuit of excellence in teamwork, leadership, commitment and perseverance. Recipients must show a strong work ethic in both practice and game environments, demonstrate good sportsmanship, a positive attitude and have a good academic record.

Value: \$1,000

U of T Mississauga Entrance Scholarship - available to all newly admitted students directly from high school with a final admission average of 95.0% and above. \$3,000 award, renewable up to \$12,000.

Value: up to \$12,000

President's Scholarship of Distinction - University of Waterloo, students admitted with an early-May admission average of 95% to any full-time, first-year degree program, beginning studies for the first time. One-time \$2,000 scholarship and the opportunity after the first year for a \$1,500 Research Award and a \$1,500 International Experience Award.

Value: \$2,000

Chancellor's Club Scholarship - University of Calgary , prestigious award offered to students applying to the University of Calgary on the basis of their high school grades and entering the first year of an undergraduate degree program in the fall term.

Value: \$10,000

New American University Scholar - Arizona State University, award offered to outstanding incoming undergraduate students as they pursue academic excellence at ASU. Renewable annually. This program provides qualified students a monetary award and an environment focusing on knowledge, learning and research plus resources toward understanding and helping solve society's most pressing challenges.

Value: \$13,000 annually

Carleton University Entrance Scholarship - awarded to students admitted to Carleton with an admissions average of 80 percent or better. Entrance scholarships are offered for fall entry only. You may be offered a renewable entrance scholarship provided you are entering Carleton for the first time from high school and have no previous attendance at post-secondary educational institutions. Renewable annually based on academic performance.

Value: up to \$4,000 annually

Arrupe Scholarship - Loyola Marymount University, awarded to first year students, this scholarship is highly competitive and selective, range in value from \$12,500 annually to full tuition, and are renewable for four years.

Value: \$12,500 annually

University of Toronto Scholars Award - University of Toronto Mississauga, entrance scholarships are guaranteed to all domestic and international students admitted to our campus with the admitted averages of above 90%.

Value: \$2,000-\$6,000

Catherine Morrish Memorial Scholarship - University of Calgary, offered annually to a female undergraduate student entering first year in any faculty. Based on academic merit.

Value: \$1,400

U of T Scholars Program - University of Toronto, open to applicants to any U of T campus. Based on academic excellence.

Value: \$7,500

Alumni Association Jean Owen Scholarship - University of Calgary, offered annually to undergraduate students entering any faculty. Based on academic merit, contribution to school and/or community life and indication of academic promise.

Value: \$3,500

Entrance Leadership Scholarship - University of Alberta, well-rounded students with admission averages of 80%+ will be assessed for scholarships to recognize their accomplishments through leadership roles.

Value: \$5,000

U of T Scarborough Entrance Scholarships - University of Toronto Scarborough, domestic students applying from secondary school who are admitted to U of T Scarborough, with an academic average of 88% or higher, will automatically be considered for scholarships. \$1,000 - \$3,000 per year. Renewable for three years.

Value: up to \$12,000

Western Scholarship of Distinction - Western University, applicants with a final admission average of 92% or higher will receive \$2,500 in first-year plus \$1,000 for an optional study abroad experience.

Value: \$3,500

Vivian Stevenson Scholarship - University of Calgary, offered annually to undergraduate students entering first year in any faculty. Based on academic merit.

Value: \$3,500

Matt Krol Memorial Scholarship - awarded to a Babe Ruth Calgary baseball player planning on attending a post-secondary institution in the fall of the year of the scholarship application.

Value: \$500

Dean's Entrance Citation in Engineering - University of Alberta, awarded to students entering the first year of an undergraduate degree program in the Faculty of Engineering. Recipients will be selected on the basis of Admission average (~95% or above). Payment of this award will commence in second year contingent upon achieving a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a full normal course load in the qualifying year. Receipt of funding for the third and fourth year is contingent upon maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a full normal course load in the Faculty of Engineering each year.

Value: \$2,500 annually

Faculty of Engineering Iron Standard Entrance Scholarship - University of Alberta, awarded to students with superior academic achievement entering the first year of an undergraduate degree in the Faculty of Engineering. Selection based on admission average.

Value: \$5,000

Excellence Scholarship - Queen's University, awarded on the basis of academic excellence to students entering the first year of a direct-entry undergraduate degree program at Queen's University.

Value: \$1,500

Presidential Scholars Award - University of British Columbia, prestigious award available to students who are entering UBC. This award recognizes students who excel across the board and who have demonstrated academic and leadership achievements in the arts, community, athletics, and school. One-time award of approximately \$5,000, and renewable awards of up to \$40,000 on the Okanagan campus, and \$80,000 on the Vancouver campus, each payable over four years.

Value: up to \$80,000

C. David Naylor University Scholarship - University of Toronto, undergraduate scholarships for students entering any first-entry program, awarded on the basis of academic merit and demonstrated leadership excellence (including, but not limited to arts, sports, music, entrepreneurship or social enterprise). Eligible candidates must have a minimum admission average of 95%.

Value: \$20,000

Kyle Stuart Memorial Scholarship - awarded to Springbank Minor Hockey Association players or referees, attending, or planning to attend, a post-secondary educational institution during the current or next school year.

Value: \$700

President's Admission Scholarship - University of Calgary, in recognition of high academic achievement. Based on a final high school average of 95.00% or higher calculated by the undergraduate Admissions Office.

Value: \$5,000

Alexander Rutherford Scholarship - to recognize and reward academic achievement of senior high school students and encourage them to pursue post-secondary studies.

Value: \$2,500

Western Scholarship of Excellence - Western University, based on top high school admission average, \$6,000 in first year, plus \$2,000 for an optional study abroad experience.

Value: \$6,000

President's Scholarships - Mount Royal University, award based on academic merit, extracurricular activities – evidence of leadership as demonstrated through extracurricular and community activities and contributions.

Value: \$7,500

Go Global Award - Award available to students at both UBC Vancouver and UBC Okanagan Exchange, Research Abroad, Global Seminars, Summer Abroad or Study Abroad travel programs are eligible.

Value: \$1,000 per term

Jimmie Condon Athletic Scholarship - available to Alberta residents enrolled full-time in an undergraduate, professional, or graduate program at a university, college, or technical institute in Alberta. Must be a member of a designated sports team and must be nominated by a coach.

Value: \$1,800

Gold Standard Scholarship - University of Alberta , awarded to the top 5% of students in each faculty. Recipients can receive up to \$6,000, depending on admission average.

Value: \$6,000

Roloff Beny Foundation Photographic Award in Fine Arts - University of Lethbridge, intended to recognize academic and artistic achievement of students with a focused interest in Photo-Arts. This award was established to provide travel opportunities to complement the creative activity of outstanding students. The funds must be used to offset costs incurred by travel, photography (equipment and/or supplies), and/or tuition or fees.

Value: \$5,000

Elizabeth Mackie Memorial Scholarship - British Columbia Institute of Technology, annual bursary and achievement award to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science, Nursing program.

Pearson Education Book Prize - McGill University, Faculty of Nursing, granted annually to one student in each year of the undergraduate programs who demonstrates high academic achievement and is awarded at graduation.

Value: \$2,000

Henry Marshall Tory Award - Carleton University, awarded to a graduating student with a high degree of academic achievement and a solid commitment to the University Students' Association and Carleton community through broad participation and leadership in constructive extra-curricular activities.

Terry Fox Humanitarian Award - open to students of all abilities and all fields of study. Award recipients are selected for their dedication to the humanitarian ideals of Terry Fox, their courage in overcoming obstacles, and definite marks of distinction and persistence in the pursuit of excellence in academic, athletic, and civic life. Awarded to those who improve human welfare, make a difference, and have a positive impact on community and others.

Value: up to \$28,000

Governor General's Caring Canadian Award - recognizes living Canadians and permanent residents who have made a significant, sustained, or unpaid contribution to their community, in Canada or abroad.

Value: \$15,000

MPE Engineering Ltd. Women in Engineering Award - University of Calgary, support for female students who are pursuing an Engineering Degree in the Schulich School of Engineering. Students must possess a superior academic record, exhibit leadership qualities and have a proven financial need.

Value: \$2,000

Derek Wandzura Memorial Scholarship - The Kids Cancer Care Derek Wandzura Memorial Scholarship is a one-time award available to childhood cancer patients and survivors, for use in post-secondary studies.

Value: \$1,000

Jason Lang Memorial Scholarship - The scholarship recognizes and rewards Alberta post-secondary students for their academic achievements and encourages them to continue in their undergraduate or professional program of study.

Value: \$1,000

TransCanada Indigenous Legacy Scholarship - Offered to First Nations, Métis, Inuit or Native American students pursuing any post-secondary education. Up to 50 awards annually.

Value: \$5,000

Imperial Oil Limited Award - University of Lethbridge, Faculty of Management, First Nations' Governance.

Value: \$1,000

Arbor Scholarship - University of Toronto, students who demonstrate superior academic performance, original and creative thought, and exceptional achievement in a broad context. They excel in academic pursuits, demonstrate enthusiasm for intellectual exploration and have a strong involvement in the lives of their schools and communities. Ten students are named Arbor Scholars. \$7,500 in the first year and \$1,500 for each of the second, third and fourth years.

Value: \$12,000

Schulich Leader Scholarships in Engineering - Recipients receive annual payments of \$25,000 over a period of four years if all renewal criteria are met. Schulich Leader Scholarships in STEM faculties outside of Engineering are valued at \$80,000.

Value: \$100,000

AMHL Scholarship - Hockey Alberta scholarship for athletes attending post-secondary.

Value: \$2,500

Ed Melville Scholarship - Calgary Royals Athletic Association Scholarship for athletes attending post-secondary.

Value: \$1,500

Seymour Schulich Academic Excellence Entrance Scholarship - University of Calgary, offered annually to undergraduate students entering first year in the Schulich School of Engineering based on exceptional academic achievement. Renewable in year two and three if criteria is met.

Value: \$13,150

Presidential Scholarship - Quest University, awarded to students who have distinguished themselves not only through their academic performance but also through their curiosity, ability to lead, and willingness to contribute to their community.

Value: \$2,000-\$8,000 annually

LMU Early Action Award - Loyola Marymount University, recognizing students of substantial academic achievement, renewable for four years.

Value: \$1,000 annually

PGA of Alberta Scholarship - four junior scholarships of \$1,000 each, awarded to deserving candidates. Two of these scholarships will be awarded to children of PGA of Alberta Members and the other two will be awarded to Alberta junior boys or girls, who meet the required criteria.

Value: \$1,000

Best in the West Entrance Scholarship - McGill University, awarded to academically qualified students from Alberta, BC, and Saskatchewan entering their first year of a full-time degree program in the Faculty of Science.

Value: \$8,000

Husky Energy Inc. Scholarship - University of Calgary, students enrolled in the Faculty of Environmental Design. Criteria includes academic excellence, extra curricular activities and research in the thematic area of Ecological Design.

Value: \$1,000

Nortel Networks Undergraduate Entrance Scholarships - Awarded to outstanding students entering Year One of Electrical and Computer Engineering.

Value: \$3,500

Prestige Award - The University of Calgary values its high achieving entering students and these awards are for those students.

Value: \$5,000 annually

Alberta Children's Hospital Diabetes Scholarship - Every year, the Alberta Children's Hospital Diabetes Clinic awards three scholarships to students with diabetes who attend our Clinic.

Value: \$500

TCU Provost's Scholars - Students who are offered the Provost's Scholarship have excelled in a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. Most are at the top of their high school graduating class.

Value: \$160,000 USD

University of Hawaii at Mānoa - The International Undergraduate Student Scholarship encourages the recruitment and retention of high-achieving international undergraduate degree-seeking students at UH Mānoa and serves the strategic and diversity goals of the university.

Value: \$64,000

University of Calgary Viscount Bennett Entrance Scholarship - Offered annually to undergraduate students entering first year in any faculty based on academic merit, good character: satisfactory personal qualities and has resided for at least five consecutive years in Calgary.

Value: \$1,000

Schulich Scholarship - One hundred are awarded to entrepreneurial-minded high school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM) program at 20 partner universities across Canada.

Value: \$120,000

President's Entrance Scholarship - University of Victoria

Value: \$3000

University of California, Riverside - International first-year and transfer applicants are automatically considered for the Achievement Scholarship upon acceptance.

Value: \$54,000 USD

Gwen Lock Scholarship for Women - Awarded to an academically outstanding woman undergraduate student entering or continuing to study Engineering or Computer Science in the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science at the University of Victoria.

Value: \$1,000

The Sonia Sennik Resilience Fund at McMaster University - an annual entrance scholarship for an Engineering student "who has shown grit and strength of character in their life – whether that's at school, at home, on the athletic field, or in their creative pursuits."

Value: \$8,000

Queen's Principal's Scholarships - given to students, who are in the top 5% of the competitive admission average for each direct-entry program into Bader College (UK).

Value: \$7,000

Postgraduate Scholarships and Awards

WD Armstrong Studentship of Engineering in Medicine - Cambridge University, awarded to students enrolled in full-time postgraduate work in the University approved by the Managers in a field related to the application of engineering in medicine. The Managers will take into account engineering competence and clinical interest and it is also expected that co-supervisors will be identified from both the School of Technology and the School of Clinical Medicine. Applications from candidates who wish to proceed to the Ph.D. Degree or other postgraduate qualification in the relevant field are invited. The Studentships are not normally intended for support of candidates who have already embarked on a course of research leading to a Ph.D.

Value: Full cost support comprising approved College and University fees and maintenance at the standard rate, together with any fee approved by the Managers for training.

The NSERC Postgraduate Scholarship – Doctoral (PGS D) program provides financial support to high-caliber scholars who are engaged in an eligible doctoral program in the natural sciences or engineering. This support allows these scholars to fully concentrate on their studies and seek out the best research mentors in their chosen fields.

Value: \$21,000

T. Chen Fong Doctoral Entrance Scholarship in Imaging Science - University of Calgary, open to students entering a full-time doctoral program in the Faculty of Graduate Studies. Applicants must complete a statement of eligibility describing how their research relates to the development or implementation of imaging science; what the candidate has already accomplished in imaging science; and the future research plan, including the potential connection with medical imaging applications if applicable. \$3,500 research allowance is reserved to cover costs associated with special equipment, conferences and/or travel in direct connection with the doctoral research.

Value: \$30,000

Alberta Innovates Health Solutions Graduate Studentship Award - Alberta Innovates funds scholarships for graduate students conducting full-time research in key emerging technology areas of information and communications technology (ICT) and advanced materials and manufacturing technologies (AMM).

Canadian Institutes for Health Research Brain Star Award - Brain Star is a program of CIHR's Institute of Neurosciences Mental Health and Addiction (CIHR-INMHA). This award is designed to recognize the excellence of research done in Canada by students and trainees in all fields and disciplines covered by CIHR-INMHA.

Value: \$1,500

Edward H. Buckley and Grace B. Buckley Graduate Scholarship - University of Toronto, from the estate of Grace B. Buckley, multiple awards are provided annually on the basis of a background of excellence, with preference given to work in Forest Environmental Science or Forest Resource management.

Value: Up to \$60,000 annually

Donnel O. Sabey, Q.C. Prize in Advocacy Law - University of Calgary, awarded to students in the Faculty of Law, LLB program based on academic excellence in Trial Advocacy.

Value: up to \$750

Terry Douglas Memorial Graduate Scholarship - University of Calgary, awarded to students enrolled in the Haskayne School of Business, Masters of Business Administration program; demonstrating leadership, interest in the mentoring of others.

Value: \$5,000

Frederick and Marguerite Hulme Scholarship - University of Calgary, applicant must be entering the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Management in the joint LL.B./M.Bus.Admin. program. Selection is based upon academic merit and financial need.

Value: \$7,500

Burnet, Duckworth & Palmer LLP Scholarship - University of Calgary, offered annually to an undergraduate student entering the Faculty of Law, JD program. Renewable in the second and third year of the program. Awarded based on community leadership and academic excellence.

Value: \$20,000
